Fifty percent of each prize will be paid directly to the winner. The remaining funds will be applied toward the winner's future musical education.

Eligibility

The Thelonious Monk Institute of Jazz International Vocals Competition is open to all performers who plan to pursue jazz performance as a career. Eligibility is exclusive to jazz vocalists who will be 29 years of age or under as of November 15, 2015. Applicants must not have any binding record label or distribution affiliations. Applicants must be free and able to accept all prize awards, including a recording contract with Concord Music Group.

Hotel accommodations and air transportation will be provided for competitors who reside outside the greater Los Angeles, CA area.

These programs help young people, college students, parents and educators develop an understanding of and appreciation for jazz.



Rules and Information

- 1. The selection of the semifinalists will be based on the audio presentation, the resume, and the application form.
- 2. The attached application form must be completed in full. Please include a \$50 application fee, a current resume of musical experience with discography, a one-paragraph biography that highlights your educational background and musical accomplishments, an audio submission (20 minutes maximum), and a hi-res photo (to be used in the printed program, if you are selected). A single USB flash drive containing files of audio tracks, hi-res photo and bio is preferred.
- 3. Please clearly label your submission with your name, telephone number, and email address. Identify the running order of the audio files. The audio submission can be a home, live and/or studio recording.
- 4. All applications must be received by September 10, 2015.
- 5. Applications, photos and audio submissions will not be returned.
- 6. Each entrant agrees that in the event he/she wins a prize in this competition, the Thelonious Monk Institute of Jazz will have the right to publicize and print his/her name and likeness, the fact that he/she won a prize, information about the competition, and all matters incidental thereto.
- 7. All federal, state and local taxes on prizes are the sole responsibility of the winner.



Performance Requirements

Please submit the following compositions in the order specified.

Improvised or composed scatting - with syllables, lyrics or over an existing/historical instrumental solo - are acceptable modes of presentation, though not required.

- 1. A ballad performance, using only one accompanying instrument, of a jazz standard, a portion of which must be sung a cappella a tempo.
- 2. A medium tempo performance of a jazz standard OR a medium tempo Latin/Brazilian composition with trio.
- 3. An uptempo performance of a jazz standard, with quartet.
- 4. A 12-bar blues of your choice with your choice of accompaniment.
- 5. A modern song (from within or without the jazz genre), original song or non-composed selection (e.g. free improv) of your choice, which is interpreted with a jazz aesthetic, with accompaniment of your choice.
